Sunday School Next Week

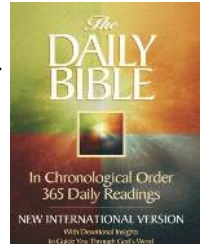
We plan to start Sunday School again next week at 9:15 am. We will provide for “social distancing” in all the classes. There will be no nursery.
